

Why Exhibit at the 57th Annual Meeting of the International Society of Electrochemistry (ISE)?

The annual ISE meeting brings together electrochemists from all over the world in probably the premier event of its kind. The 2006 event will be held at Heriot-Watt University in Edinburgh from 27th August to 1st September 2006 and will host around 1000 delegates from all electrochemical disciplines. The theme of this year's Meeting is "Innovative Electrochemistry, Enterprising Science".

The UK has a long and distinguished record in electrochemistry, dating back to the brilliant innovations and insights of Michael Faraday in fundamental electrochemistry and the far-reaching enterprise of William Groves in applying electrochemistry to fuel cells. These and related concepts drove the rise of electrochemistry as a central topic in industry and science education in the latter half of the 20th century.

Electrochemistry now contributes to a huge range of materials, devices and products that enhance enormously our health, comfort, transport, commercial activity and entertainment. Through new technologies, notably with regard to energy and the environment, electrochemistry is also likely to play a major role in saving us from several impending crises. It is therefore timely that we explore the ways in which electrochemistry can be a positive factor in both near-future economic opportunities and, through deeper understanding, more distant prospects.

The 57th Annual Meeting of the International Society of Electrochemistry offers your organisation the opportunity to show its products and services to an important concentration of decision makers in technologically promising and high-growth fields.

The Exhibition

The Conference Organizers have reserved 14 booth areas for commercial exhibitors.

Exhibition Package:

Space for each exhibitor has been arranged adjacent to the main Auditorium to ensure maximum possible interaction with the delegates. The booths are also next to the coffee areas and the poster displays. There are two types of Booths:

(A) Booths No 1 to No2 reserved to sponsors of the congress: 10 square meters (2.5 meters by 4.0 meters);

(B) Booths No 3 to No 14 for regular exhibitors: 6.0 square meters (2.0 meters by 3.0 meters).

The cost of renting each exhibition booth will be **2500 Euro + VAT**

Placements are marked on the layout supplied on the Exhibitor Agreement Form. A table and chairs will be provided upon request. There are several electrical outlets available at each booth location.

In addition, each commercial exhibitor will receive a free registration for one person (which includes badges, session programs, registrants' kits and meals) and will receive a full list of the attendees to the congress.

Set up: The exhibition area will be open for exhibitor set-up on the 28th August between the hours of 8:00 AM and 10:30 PM. We ask exhibitors not to continue after these hours so that the participants may enjoy the inaugural lectures and welcome reception.

Break Down: The Congress ends at lunchtime on the 1st September. It is required that the exhibitors return their exhibit space to its original condition before leaving that day. However, we ask that the exhibitors do NOT break down their booths before the Friday morning. The work can be carried out until 5:00 PM, at the latest.
